Vision


Sudbury Arts Council brings attention and support to the artistic community in Greater Sudbury. SAC encourages participation and appreciation of art throughout the community. We strive to advocate and promote for arts and culture groups in our city, understanding the deeply important role they play in making up our unique arts scene and overall culture. We are committed to encouraging emerging artists and assisting them to establish a network within the artistic community. We strive to broaden the audience for the arts.

History

SAC is a non-profit organization founded July 31, 1974. Over its 50-year+ history, it was instrumental in the establishment of Cinéfest, the Artists' Studio Tour, and the Sudbury Writers' Guild. It has sponsored Arts Crawls supported the establishment of and Wordstock Literary Festival in 2013. It was a co-creator of the Sudbury Celebration of the Arts (Mayor's Celebration of the Arts), an awards gala. SAC established Gallery 6500, an art gallery at the local Steelworkers' Hall. Another successful initiative organized by SAC was the Passport to the Arts program, which offered a sampling of arts experiences which helped build capacity. In October 2022, the arts council hosted Rendezvous North, a highly successful conference for Northern Ontario arts.
